

Telligen's Quality Payment Program Initiative Fact Sheet

The Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act (MACRA) of 2015 sun-set the PQRS, Value-Based Modifier (VM) and Medicare EHR Incentive programs on December 31, 2016. The new Quality Payment Program includes two paths: the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) and Advanced Alternative Payment Models (APMs). Most Medicare clinicians will initially participate in the Quality Payment Program through MIPS.



Telligen will now assist eligible clinicians in the transition from the existing Medicare reporting programs into the new Quality Payment Program. In 2017 and 2018, MIPS eligible clinicians (ECs) include physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, clinical nurse specialists, and certified registered nurse anesthetists. Additional provider types will be affected in future years.

We will help eligible clinicians better understand the four MIPS performance categories of quality, cost, advancing care information and clinical practice improvement activities and explain the effects of the MIPS score on Medicare reimbursement. Our experts will provide information and education on Advanced Alternative Payment Models.
